The Picacho Elementary School District has developed a Reopening and Mitigation Plan to follow Governor Ducey's Executive Order 2020-51. We are limited in staff and resources but will work diligently to meet all the needs of our students identified in this Executive Order.

PESD plan to comply with the Executive Order 2020-51:

- Picacho Elementary School will open the school doors to service our at-risk population beginning on Monday August 17, 2020. On-site support service hours will be Monday-Friday, 8:00am-3:00pm.
- This service will be provided until school officially reopens.
- PESD will use the AZ Department of Health Services COVID19 metrics data to determine a date when it will be safe to reopen in-person.
- PESD will allow a limited number of students on-site as to provide a safe environment and meet the CDC regulations. Priority will be given to special needs students and English Language Learners.
- All parents or guardians choosing on-site support services MUST sign a waiver.
- Students will be screened and required to wear a mask.
- Transportation will be provided for students attending if it is stated in their IEP's.
- Breakfast/Lunch will be a Grab-n-Go.
